

Children's Choir of Huntington County, Inc.
Scholarship Guidelines
Choral Season 2017 - 2018

The availability of scholarships is limited and subject to funds available.

Application:

A parent or guardian interested in applying for a scholarship for their child, or children, may do so by applying to the Children's Choir of Huntington County, Inc. A new scholarship application must be submitted each choral season. One scholarship application per family is sufficient. **Deadline for application submission is August 16, 2017.**

Notice of Confidentiality:

All scholarship applications and scholarship recipients will be kept confidential.

Amount Awarded:

Scholarships awarded will be a percentage of tuition determined by the Scholarship Chairperson. The maximum amount awarded per scholarship will be 90% of tuition. Additional fees such as uniforms and choral trips will be the responsibility of the child's parent or guardian. CCHC Parent Association organizes fundraisers throughout the choral season to help raise funds for the choral members' fees. 90% of profit earned by each student is credited to them and applied toward tuition, uniforms, and other fees.

Scholarship Eligibility:

Scholarship eligibility guidelines are based on financial need and consider a variety of factors including, but not limited to, income, household size, and financial hardship due to circumstances. Scholarship Applicants are required to fill out the scholarship application and include a copy of the first page of their last year's tax return (please black out social security numbers) and a copy of the letter from the school verifying free or reduced breakfast and lunch status (if applicable).

Recipient Expectations:

Recipients are expected to commit to the entire choral season, August-**April**. If a choir member receives a scholarship and does not complete the season, he/she will be required to reimburse the choir for the unused scholarship and remaining tuition balance.

Volunteerism:

Any family awarded a scholarship is **required** to volunteer their time to CCHC activities.

Scholarship application and supporting information must be postmarked by August 16, 2017.
